Breakfast Club will operate 5 days per week every morning from 8.30-9am. This is for all students. The school welcomes any donations of bread, milk, fruit etc.





## Absence text messages


Each fortnight the school office sends out an SMS to parents of students who have been absent without a note sent in or a phone call.
